RESOLUTION NO. 2022-04

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE INTENT OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PORT AUSTIN, MICHIGAN, TO VACATE A PUBLIC ALLEY LOCATED IN BLOCK 15, AYRES AND CO. ADDITION TO THE VILLAGE OF PORT AUSTIN, AND TO SCHEDULE A PUBLIC HEARING FOR THE PURPOSE OF RECEIVING COMMENTS REGARDING THE SAME.

WHEREAS, the Village of Port Austin has received a request to vacate a public alley located between Adams Street and Bridge Street, Block 15, Ayres & Co. Addition to the Village of Port Austin, Huron County, Michigan.

WHEREAS, said alley has never been developed, improved, or used as alley; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council has the authority to vacate, discontinue, or abolish a highway, street, lane, alley, or public ground, pursuant to the procedures contained in Section 13 of the General Law Village Act (MCL 67.13); and

WHEREAS, the Village Council deems it in the best interest of the Village to vacate and abandon said alley as above described.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village Council of the Village of Port Austin hereby declares its intent to vacate the public alley located between Adams Street and Bridge Street, as dedicated and depicted in Block 15 of the Plat for Ayres & Company Addition to the Village of Port Austin, within the Village of Port Austin, Huron County, Michigan.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the vacation of said alley shall be subject to the Village of Port Austin reserving and retaining a full-width easement in the dedicated area of the vacated street for public utility purposes and for other public purposes, said easement being reserved and retained by and for the benefit of the Village of Port Austin.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that all existing easements and utility uses and rights within the area vacated shall remain for the use and enjoyment of the owners of said easements and utility uses and rights. The same shall not be diminished or otherwise affected by this Resolution.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the Village Council hereby appoints the 12th day of December, 2022, at 6:15 p.m., as the date and time at which the Village Council shall meet and hear objections to this Resolution, as provided in MCL 67.13, and the Village Clerk is hereby

directed to provide notice of the meeting, with a copy of this Resolution, in the manner prescribed by the Open Meetings Act, 1976 PA 267, MCL 15.261 to 15.275.
